12. Permittee agrees to restore surface to its original condition where extensive damage occurs.
13. The terms and conditions of the SEISMIC EXPLORATION PERMIT (CLO Form 7-115) are incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference, and we expressly agree to comply with them.
